- Maharashtra has 2nd Highest Tribal Population in India ~105.10Lakhs (2011 census) in India next to Madhya Pradesh
- There are 45 Scheduled Tribe Communities in Maharashtra,
- Main Tribes: Bhils, Gonds, Mahadeo Kolis, Pawras, Thakurs and Warlis
- Primitive Tribes (Notified By Gol):
 - The Kolams (Yavatmal District),
 - The Katkaris (mainly in Raigad, Thane and Palghar Districts) and
 - The Madia Gonds (Gadchiroli District),
- Tribal Population is largely concentrated in:
 - Western Hilly Districts: Dhule, Nandurbar, Jalgaon, Nashik, Palghar and Thane (Sahyadri Region)
 - Eastern Forest Districts: Chandrapur, Gadchiroli, Bhandara, Gondia, Nagpur, Amravati and Yavatmal (Gondwana Region).
